

The result of the collaboration between the USGA and Golf Genius Software is **USGA Tournament Management**, which is a USGA-branded version of the established and successful Golf Genius tournament management system that replaces TPP® and provides additional benefits.

The Fairwood Golf and Country Club utilizes the Golf Genius software to manage over 30+ internal and external tournaments per year. The Members of the Club enjoy the fast scoring, tee assignments and notifications the software allows the professional staff to manage during or for tournaments and golf play.

The "Live" Scoring on video screens is a huge hit for many tournaments. Players enjoy seeing their place within a tournament immediately after play while enjoying their first cocktail of celebration with other players.

The Golf Genius App is free to download for the golfers and login will be unique to your event!

Along with the "LIVE" Scoring feature we can place hole sponsors and advertisements of your choice in between holes on the App!

Another great feature you can utilize is our registration process using Golf Genius. We can set up the registration page with any information you wish. You can also set up payment with Golf Genius for entry fees or donations.

Hosting a Private Tournament at Fairwood

TO START...

The requests for tournament dates must be submitted in writing to the Head Golf Professional and/or General Manager for approval by the Fairwood Golf Committee. We encourage interested groups to reserve your dates early, Fairwood Golf and Country Club hosts an average of only seven Private Tournaments per year at the Memberships approval.

No dates will be reserved without contract and deposit. Returning events will still need to reserve in advance to secure their future date (s).

SPECIAL TOURNAMENT & COURSE ARRANGEMENTS

The Tournament Director (host) shall notify the Professional Staff, in writing, at least **seven (7) business days** in advance for any special arrangements regarding course set-up, competitions, registration and scoring requirements. <u>ALL</u> course set-up must be approved by Club Management (*i.e. Hole Sponsors, donations, etc.*). A tournament representative is required on site at least one (1) hour in advance of the earliest starting time.

RULES OF PLAY

Fairwood expects all tournament participants to understand the basic rules of golf and golf etiquette, such as, speed of play, divot and ball mark repair, and general respect for the condition of the golf course. The Tournament Director (host) will be responsible for payment of any and all damages incurred by any player in the tournament if the individual or party does not come forward. All costs associated with damages will be in billing for event.

- The Club, at it's discretion, may require a course marshal with full authority to regulate the standard rules of play. Should a marshal be required, it will be at the cost of the tournament principals.
- FAIRWOOD IS A SOFT SPIKE FACILITY. Please be sure that all your participants are notified.
- Fairwood Golf and Country Club maintains its course condition through annual aerification that is regularly scheduled in the months of **April** and **September**. Fairwood cannot guarantee prime golfing conditions within these months.
- We require ALL players to practice course care and use sand/seed bottles located within golf carts and on course.
- All players should return golf cart and score card to Golf Shop area to expedite the scoring process for event.
- All players are responsible for an damage to club equipment, course or surrounding properties due to their negligence, accident, or mishap.

DRESS CODE/CELL PHONE POLICY

All participants and volunteers must comply with the Club dress code! In short, we ask that all participants, volunteers, employees or other to wear a collared shirt and **no denim or cargo style shorts** /slacks on premise. The Fairwood Staff are directed to DENY ACCESS to anyone not in compliance with the dress code.



Cellular Telephone usage is not permitted within Clubhouse or Golf Course. Please adjust your cell phone to a silent mode while on premise. Thank you!





FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE

All arrangements for food and beverage shall be made 30 days in advance, with Club's Catering Staff. The Club must provide ALL food and beverage on premises unless approved by Club Management. This shall include clubhouse, practice areas, golf course and surrounds.

Our talented Chef, Brendan Vermillion can assist in you in a wide range of culinary offerings from a simple BBQ to a formal table service awards dinner.

All Food & Beverage must be approved through Fairwood Golf and Country Club. For planning, menu selection and services, please contact:

Minimum requirements for dining will be based from the participant (players) field and volunteer/ sponsor counts provided by Tournament Director (host) at a minimum price of \$35.00 per person, plus 20% service charge, and state sales tax.

Final food arrangements and a number of person GUARANTEE must be completed seven (7) business days in ADVANCE OF THE EVENT.

The use of alcoholic beverages must be in compliance with the Washington State Law. ALL donated/sponsored or other alcohol beverages require a Washington State Banquet Permit for consumption on Club property. *https://lcb.wa.gov/licensing/online-banquet-permit*

Special Event Insurance

All private events are required to provide liability insurance, through your personal/company insurance.

If you are having a public event, whether a wedding and reception or a festival, you need the protection of Special Event Insurance. The Event Liability Insurance is designed to protect the policyholder against lawsuits, claims made related to bodily injury of others, and property damage to the rented premise. They provide Special Event Liability Insurance through our Commercial General Liability (CGL) policy, often called Spectator or Public Liability Insurance, which satisfies the requirements of most rental locations.

Schedule a meeting with Head Golf Professional on format of play, special competitions, awards, pairings, cart order and/or specials needs. *See page 14 for special course requirements.*

(Note - NO tournament date is confirmed or secured without contract form)

Schedule a meeting with Catering Staff on event space, special set-ups, awards presentations, menu(s), sponsor requests on course and in clubhouse and/or any other specials needs.

Submit Preliminary Participant/Player, Volunteer or other counts.

Schedule a meeting with Head Golf Professional & Catering Department to review all event details, special arrangements and counts.

Finalize ALL counts, competitions, course set-up, menu(s) and equipment orders.

Delivery of ALL sponsorship materials and supplies. Items delivered day of must be checked in with management of Club.


